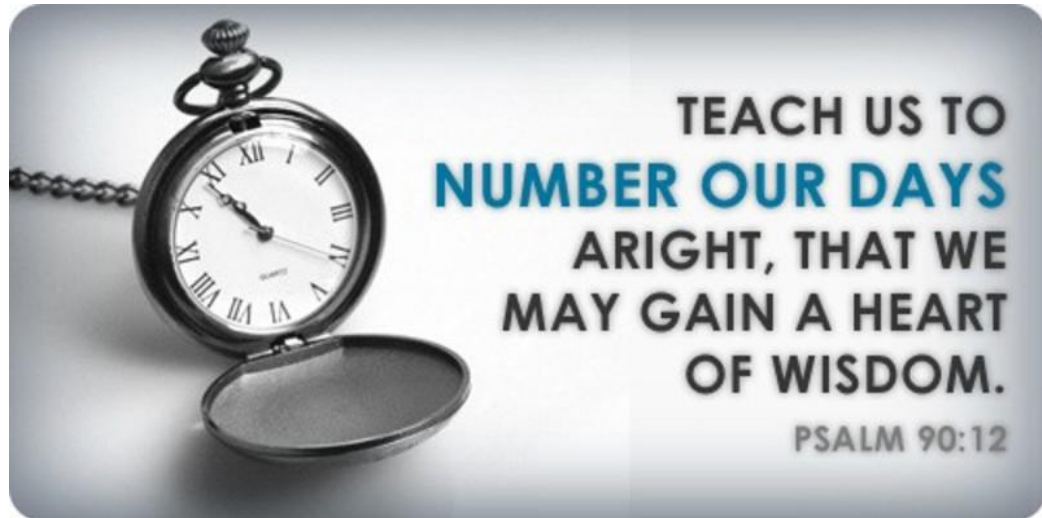

Welcome to Cornerstone!

Today Phil Hague will be bringing God's Word from Psalm 90, the only psalm of Moses in the book of Psalms. Next week Paul Hutchens from Soul Church will preach, and on April 29 Dan Probert will preach from Matthew 29:29-34.

Psalm 90

Psalm 90:1 A prayer of Moses the man of God. Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations. ² Before the mountains were born or you brought forth the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God. ³ You turn men back to dust, saying, "Return to dust, O sons of men." ⁴ For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night. ⁵ You sweep men away in the sleep of death; they are like the new grass of the morning-- ⁶ though in the morning it springs up new, by evening it is dry and withered. ⁷ We are consumed by your anger and terrified by your indignation. ⁸ You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your presence. ⁹ All our days pass away under your wrath; we finish our years with a moan. ¹⁰ The length of our days is seventy years-- or eighty, if we have the strength; yet their span is but trouble and sorrow, for they quickly pass, and we fly away. ¹¹ Who knows the power of your anger? For your wrath is as great as the fear that is due you. ¹² Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom. ¹³ Relent, O LORD! How long will it be? Have compassion on your servants. ¹⁴ Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days. ¹⁵ Make us glad for as many days as you have afflicted us, for as many years as we have seen trouble. ¹⁶ May your deeds be shown to your servants, your splendor to their children. ¹⁷ May the favor of the Lord our God rest upon us; establish the work of our hands for us-- yes, establish the work of our hands.

Reflecting on Calvin and Hobbes

Calvin and Hobbes provided one of the great cartoons of the 1990s because it so perfectly captured the growing no-fault ethos of the decade. The cartoon is mostly a monologue by Calvin, a little boy, to his tiger friend Hobbes. It begins with the two walking along and Calvin musing, "Nothing I do is my fault." The next frame shows Hobbes scratching his whiskers as Calvin expostulates, "My family is dysfunctional and my parents won't empower me! Consequently, I'm not self-actualised." Then we see Calvin, eyes shut and arms crossed, doing a poor me: "My behaviour is addictive, functioning in a disease process of toxic co-dependency! I need holistic wellness before I'll accept responsibility for my actions!" Hobbes responds, "One of us needs to stick his head in a bucket of ice water." The strip ends with Calvin walking on saying, "I love the culture of victimhood."
